

# St. Philip

**P**hilip, born in Bethsaida, Palestine, was among the first of Jesus' disciples and brought Bartholomew (Nathanael) to Jesus (John 1:43-46). Philip is mentioned in connection with the feeding of the 5,000 (John 6:5-7), Jesus' meeting with the Greeks (John 12:21-23) and with Jesus' discourse at the Last Supper (John 14:9). He is believed to have preached in Greece and Asia Minor.

FEAST DAY: May 3

JOHN 14:8-9 *Philip said to him, "Master, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us."*

*Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you for so long a time and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"*
