

# St. James

**J**ames of Zebedee was a disciple of John the Baptist and a fisherman before becoming an Apostle. Also known as James the Greater, he was among the three witnesses at the Transfiguration of Christ (Matthew 17:1) and the Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26:37). Jesus called James and his brother, St. John the Apostle, “Boanerges,” meaning “the sons of thunder” (Mark 3:17). James was the first of the Apostles to be martyred, having been beheaded under Herod Agrippa in 44.

**FEAST DAY:** July 25

**MARK 10:37-39** *They answered him, “Grant that in your glory we may sit one at your right and the other at your left.”*

*Jesus said to them, “You do not know what you are asking. Can you drink the cup that I drink or be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?”*

*They said to him, “We can.”*

*Jesus said to them, “The cup that I drink, you will drink, and with the baptism with which I am baptized, you will be baptized...”*
